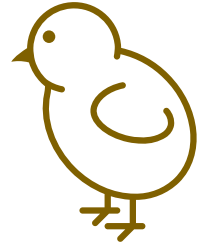
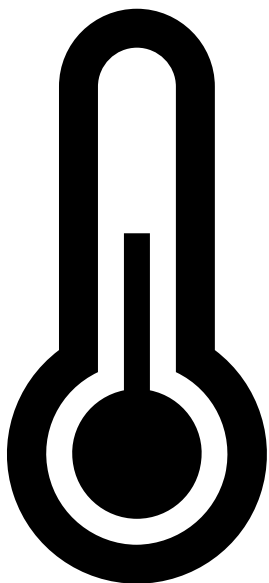


Baby Chick Tip Sheet



Items needed for new chicks	
	Brooder (Gerbil Cage, Puppy Play Pen or Child's Pack and Play)
	Pine Shavings
	Waterer (If using one with open water, make sure it's up high or not filled. Chicks can drown if they fall asleep in the water)
	Baby Feed (crumbles)
	Small feeder (You won't want to food all over as they will poop in it)
	Heat Lamp (get the brooder up to 95degrees before they come home)
	Thermometer (lay it flat to make sure the temp is correct)
	Chick grit (you'll want to add some chick grit into their food or have separate container)



95 degrees – day old to one week

90 degrees – 1-2 weeks old

85 degrees – 2-3 weeks old

80 degrees – 3-4 weeks old

75 degrees – 4-5 weeks old

70 degrees – 5-6 weeks old

*At 6 weeks old, depending on your area and time of year, they may be fully feathered and they can go outside to their coop.
